Dom Paulino OSB



A Chapter in the life of the Catholic Church in Western Australia came to an end on 18 January, 2010, when Dom Paulino Gutierrez, the last of New Norcia's Spanish-born monks, died.

At his death, Dom Paulino was almost a century old, having reached the venerable age of 99 years.

Dom Paulino was born in Villaepasa in Spain, entered the El Pueyo monastery in 1924 and came to New Norcia in 1928, 15 years after the Marist Brothers commenced at St Ildephonsus College.

During his time at the monastery Dom Paulino served as a baker, a miller, a cobbler and finally, as a maker of the well-known monastery olive oil.



The Brothers were represented at the requiem by Br Noel Hickey, a former student and winner of the Lord Abbott scholarship to St Ildephonsus College.
