



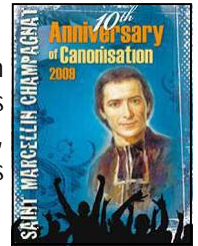
Principals' Email Stream

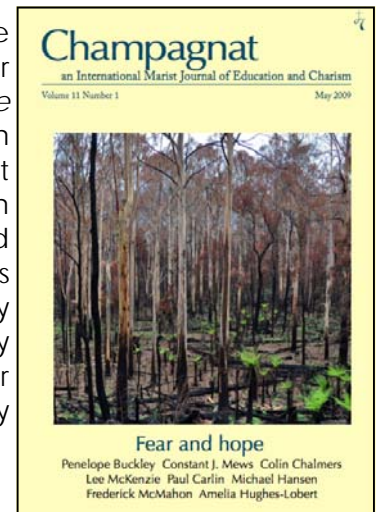
